Review Process

The International Journal for Dispute Resolution follows a Peer Review Process.

The process follows the following steps:

- 1. The Manuscripts submitted through the submission form are assigned a manuscript code.
- 2. After this, all the details of the author(s) are removed from the manuscript.
- 3. The manuscript is then sent to two members of our reviewing team, who review the manuscript based on the quality of the research and the relevancy of the topics. Note: These members are not from the honorary editorial board.
- 4. After evaluating the articles, both editors assign the manuscript a score out of 5.
- 5. The manuscripts that get a combined score of 5 or above out of 10 are selected for final publication.
