

Publication Process

The *International Journal for Constitution and Development of Law (IJCDL)* follows a swift and structured publication process, ensuring timely dissemination of scholarly work. The entire process, from manuscript submission to the issuance of publication certificates, is designed to be completed within **7 working days**.

Step-by-Step Process:

1. **Manuscript Submission:**

Authors submit their manuscripts through the submission form.

2. **Acknowledgment:**

Upon receipt, an acknowledgment email containing the **Manuscript ID** is sent to the author(s).

3. **Peer Review:**

The manuscript undergoes a **peer review process**, where it is evaluated by independent reviewers (not part of the editorial board) based on the quality of research and relevance of the topic. [Read more about our review process here.](#)

4. **Selection Notification:**

If the manuscript is selected, the author(s) receive a confirmation email regarding its acceptance.

5. **Processing Fee Payment:**

Authors are required to pay a **Manuscript Processing Fee** upon selection:

- **INR 700/- or \$10** for single-authored manuscripts
- **INR 1000/- or \$20** for co-authored manuscripts

6. **Publication:**

After successful payment, the manuscript is published in the journal.

7. **Certificate Issuance:**

Authors receive a **soft copy of the publication certificate** via email.

Note: While the process is designed to be completed within 7 working days, unforeseen circumstances may lead to slight delays.
