

Review Process

The *International Journal for Constitution and Development of Law (IJCDL)* follows a **Peer Review Process** to ensure the quality and credibility of published works.

The Review Process involves the following steps:

1. Manuscripts submitted through the submission form are assigned a unique Manuscript ID.
2. Author details are removed from the manuscript to maintain anonymity.
3. The anonymous manuscript is sent to **two independent reviewers** (who are **not members of the Honorary Editorial Board**) for evaluation.
4. Reviewers assess the manuscript based on:
 - Quality of research
 - Relevance to the field
5. Each reviewer assigns a score **out of 5** to the manuscript.
6. Manuscripts that receive a **combined score of 5 or more out of 10** are selected for final publication.
